6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Resolution relating to the House of  
8 Representatives; establishing an order of business  
9 for the House of Representatives for the 1st  
10 Extraordinary Session of the 54th Oklahoma  
11 Legislature.

12 WHEREAS, Rule 7.23 of the Rules of the House of Representatives  
13 of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature requires the Calendar Committee to  
14 propose a regular order of business for the House of  
15 Representatives; and

16 WHEREAS, pursuant to House Rule 7.23, the Calendar Committee  
17 hereby proposes for consideration by the House of Representatives  
18 the following daily order of business for the House of  
19 Representatives for the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 54th  
20 Oklahoma Legislature.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
22 OF THE 1ST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

23 THAT the following Order of Business shall be followed each day:

24 1. Roll Call;

1        2. Prayer, the timing of which shall be left to the discretion  
2 of the Majority Floor Leader;

3        3. Inspirational Message by Chaplain, the timing of which shall  
4 be left to the discretion of the Majority Floor Leader;

5        4. Introduction of the Veteran of the Week, the timing of which  
6 shall be left to the discretion of the Majority Floor Leader;

7        5. Pledge of Allegiance, the timing of which shall be left to  
8 the discretion of the Majority Floor Leader;

9        6. Correction of the Previous Day's Journal;

10       7. House and Senate Bills and Joint Resolutions on Second  
11 Reading, the timing of which shall be left to the discretion of the  
12 Majority Floor Leader;

13       8. Assignment or Reassignment of Bills and Resolutions, the  
14 timing of which shall be left to the discretion of the Majority  
15 Floor Leader;

16       9. House and Senate Bills and Joint Resolutions on the Consent  
17 Calendar;

18       10. Bills, Resolutions, Conference Committee Reports and Joint  
19 Committee Reports scheduled by the House Calendar Committee; and

20       11. Motions placing new business before the House. The  
21 Majority Floor Leader shall schedule said motions upon the same
