7 A Resolution relating to the House of
8 Representatives; establishing an order of business
9 for the House of Representatives for the First
10 Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature.

12 WHEREAS, Rule 7.23 of the Rules of the House of Representatives
13 of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature requires the Calendar Committee to
14 propose a regular order of business for the House of
15 Representatives; and

16 WHEREAS, the Calendar Committee met on Monday, February 4, 2013,
17 and adopted a proposed order of business for the House of
18 Representatives; and

19 WHEREAS, pursuant to House Rule 7.23, the Calendar Committee
20 hereby proposed for consideration by the House of Representatives
21 the following daily order of business for the House of
22 Representatives for the First Session of the 54th Oklahoma
23 Legislature.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
2 OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

3 THAT the following Order of Business shall be followed each day:

4 1. Roll Call;

5 2. Prayer, the timing of which shall be left to the discretion
6 of the Majority Floor Leader;

7 3. Inspirational Message by Chaplain on Thursday mornings, the
8 timing of which shall be left to the discretion of the Majority
9 Floor Leader;

10 4. Introduction of the Veteran of the Week on Monday mornings,
11 the timing of which shall be left to the discretion of the Majority
12 Floor Leader;

13 5. Pledge of Allegiance on Monday mornings, the timing of which
14 shall be left to the discretion of the Majority Floor Leader;

15 6. Introduction of a Doctor and/or Nurse of the Day, the timing
16 of which shall be left to the discretion of the Majority Floor
17 Leader;

18 7. Correction of the Previous Day's Journal;

19 8. House and Senate Bills and Joint Resolutions on Second
20 Reading, the timing of which shall be left to the discretion of the
21 Majority Floor Leader;

22 9. Assignment or Reassignment of Bills and Resolutions, the
23 timing of which shall be left to the discretion of the Majority
24 Floor Leader;

1 10. House and Senate Bills and Joint Resolutions on the Consent
2 Calendar;

3 11. Bills, Resolutions, Conference Committee Reports and Joint
4 Committee Reports scheduled by the House Calendar Committee; and

5 12. Motions placing new business before the House. The
6 Majority Floor Leader shall schedule said motions upon the same
7 legislative day, the timing of which shall be left to the discretion
8 of the Majority Floor Leader.
