7 AS INTRODUCED

8 A Resolution proclaiming April 2, 2013, as the 17th
9 Annual 4-H Day at the State Capitol; recognizing 4-H
10 as the largest youth development organization in the
11 state and the nation; and challenging others to join
12 their Revolution of Responsibility.

13 WHEREAS, 4-H youth across the nation are leading a revolution of
14 responsibility in their communities, focusing on the fourth H -
15 Health: Health for better living in my club, my community, my
16 country, and my world; and

17 WHEREAS, 4-H is the largest youth development organization in
18 Oklahoma and the largest in the nation with six million young
19 people; and

20 WHEREAS, 4-H in Oklahoma reaches 114,000 youth members and 9,000
21 volunteers annually; and

22 WHEREAS, 4-H is part of the Oklahoma Cooperative Extension
23 Service provided by Langston University and Oklahoma State
24 University, where youth are encouraged to discover their passion,

1 adopt a growth mindset, practice self-reflection and set goals which
2 contribute to a healthy lifestyle; and

3 WHEREAS, 4-H has connected youth and their communities with the
4 innovative research and resources from our nation's 106 land-grant
5 universities and colleges for more than 100 years; and

6 WHEREAS, 4-H youth are the "now", the living, breathing,
7 cultural change agents leading a revolution of responsibility for
8 doing the right thing, breaking through obstacles and making a
9 measurable difference in the communities and state where they live.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
11 OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

12 THAT Tuesday, April 2, 2013, is hereby proclaimed as the "17th
13 Annual 4-H Day" at the State Capitol, celebrating youth who have
14 made an impact on their community and accepted the challenges of a
15 complex and changing world, and challenging others to join their
16 "Revolution of Responsibility".
