8 A Resolution commending the Northwest Chamber for 75

6 Northwest Young Professionals, programs which inform and develop new  
7 community leaders, equipping them for community service, both now

9       WHEREAS, the Northwest Chamber is a champion for small  
10 businesses, providing opportunities for personal and professional  
11 growth, team development, and community prosperity.

12       NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
13 OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
