6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to restricted license plates;
8 requiring the Oklahoma Tax Commission to issue a
9 certain restricted license plate under certain
10 circumstances; requiring the Commission to provide
11 for such license plate; setting requirements for the
12 plate; providing for codification; and providing an
13 effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-212.5 of Title 47, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. Whenever the records of the Department of Public Safety
19 reflect a second revocation of the driving privilege of a person as
20 provided in paragraph 2 of subsection A of Section 6-205.1 of Title
21 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Department shall, after the
22 mandatory period of revocation as prescribed by Section 6-205.1 of
23 Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, submit notice to the Oklahoma Tax
24 Commission for such person to be reissued a restricted license plate
as provided in subsection B of this section for a period of five (5)
years following the mandatory revocation. The Department shall

1 require the person to return the current license plate assigned to
2 that motor vehicle to the Department and all costs for re-issuance
3 shall be paid by the person. All annual renewal fees shall still
4 apply. If the person has a third revocation at any time, then the
5 license plate shall be issued for ten (10) years.

6 B. The Commission shall provide for a restricted license plate
7 as provided in subsection A that shall be yellow in color with red
8 lettering.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.

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
