6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to speech-language pathology and
8 audiology; amending 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1607, as
9 amended by Section 1, Chapter 59, O.S.L. 2012 (59
10 O.S. Supp. 2012, Section 1607), which relates to the
11 Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and
12 Audiology; clarifying language; and providing an
13 effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1607, as
16 amended by Section 1, Chapter 59, O.S.L. 2012 (59 O.S. Supp. 2012,
17 Section 1607), is amended to read as follows:

18 Section 1607. A. There is hereby re-created, to continue until
19 July 1, 2015, in accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma
20 Sunset Law, the Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and
21 Audiology ~~whose~~. The duty it is of the Board shall be to administer
22 the provisions of the Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology
23 Licensing Act. The members of the Board shall be residents of this
24 state and shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice and
consent of the Senate. The Board shall be composed of five (5)

1 members consisting of three licensed speech-language pathologists or
2 audiologists, provided that at least one of the three shall be a
3 licensed speech-language pathologist and at least one a licensed
4 audiologist; one otolaryngologist who is certified by the American
5 Board of Otolaryngology and one lay member.

6 B. The members of the original Board shall serve the following
7 terms: one member for one (1) year, two members for two (2) years,
8 and two members for three (3) years. Thereafter, at the expiration
9 of the term, or termination of the member's service for any reason,
10 the Governor shall appoint each successor for a term of three (3)
11 years, or for the remainder of an unexpired term. The successor for
12 any of the three speech-language pathologists or audiologists will
13 be selected from a list of five licensed speech-language
14 pathologists or audiologists, furnished by the Oklahoma Speech-
15 Language-Hearing Association. The re-creation of the Board shall
16 not affect the staggered terms of office for Board members
17 established with the original Board.

18 C. Before entering upon the duties of the member's office, each
19 member of the Board shall take the Constitutional oath of office and
20 file it with the Secretary of State.

21 D. Board members may be reappointed to serve one additional
22 three-year term. Three (3) years after the termination of a
23 previous appointment to the Board, a member may be reappointed for
24 one additional three-year term.

1 E. Board members shall be reimbursed for travel expenses
2 incurred in the performance of their duties as provided in the State
3 Travel Reimbursement Act.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.

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
