6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to virtual education; amending  
8 Section 1, Chapter 108, O.S.L. 2013 (70 O.S. Supp.  
9 2013, Section 3-145.6), which relates to virtual  
10 education providers; directing virtual education  
11 providers and the district with which it contracts to  
12 submit certain information electronically to the  
13 State Department of Education; providing an effective  
14 date; and declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 108, O.S.L.  
17 2013 (70 O.S. Supp. 2013, Section 3-145.6), is amended to read as  
18 follows:

19 Section 3-145.6. A. A virtual education provider that offers  
20 full-time virtual education to students who are not residents of the  
21 school district with which the provider is contracted shall be  
22 considered a site within each school district with which the  
23 provider contracts and subject to the accountability system  
24 established pursuant to Section 1210.545 of this title.

B. The virtual education provider and the school district with  
which it contracts are hereby directed to identify those students

1 who are full-time virtual students and do not live in the physical  
2 boundaries of the district. The district and provider shall submit  
3 in electronic format as necessary to the State Department of  
4 Education detailed data on the performance of non-resident students  
5 who are receiving full-time instruction.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2014.

7 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
8 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
9 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
10 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
