6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to pharmacists; amending 59 O.S.  
8 2011, Section 353.3, which relates to the State Board  
9 of Pharmacy; clarifying language; and providing an  
10 effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 353.3, is  
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 353.3. A. The State Board of Pharmacy shall consist of  
15 six (6) persons, five who shall be licensed as pharmacists by this  
16 state and one who shall be a public member.

17 1. The pharmacist members shall be appointed by the Governor by  
18 and with the advice and consent of the Senate and shall:

19 a. be registered and in good standing in the State of  
20 Oklahoma,

21 b. have been actively engaged in the practice of pharmacy  
22 within this state for a period of not less than five  
23 (5) years immediately prior to serving on the Board.  
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1        2. The public member shall be appointed by the Governor and  
2 shall:

3            a. be a resident of the State of Oklahoma for not less  
4            than five (5) years, and

5            b. not be a pharmacist or be related by blood or marriage  
6            within the third degree of consanguinity to a  
7            pharmacist.

8        B. The present members of the Board shall continue to serve the  
9 remainder of their terms. Successors shall be appointed for a term  
10 of five (5) years. The public member of the Board shall serve a  
11 term coterminous with the Governor and shall serve at the pleasure  
12 of the Governor. The terms of the members of the Board shall expire  
13 on ~~the 30th day of June~~ June 30 of the year designated for the  
14 expiration of the term for which appointed but the member shall  
15 serve until a qualified successor has been duly appointed. No  
16 person shall be appointed to serve more than two consecutive terms.  
17 ~~Said~~ The appointments shall be made from a list of ten (10) names  
18 representative of the pharmacy profession submitted annually by the  
19 Executive Director of the Oklahoma Pharmaceutical Association after  
20 an election has been held by mail ballot.

21        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.

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
