6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to unfair sales; stating legislative
8 intent; deleting the prohibition to selling below
9 cost, penalties, definitions, injunctive relief and
10 right to use; repealing 15 O.S. 2011, Sections 598.1,
11 598.2, 598.3, 598.4, 598.5, 598.6, 598.7, 598.8,
12 598.9, 598.10 and 598.11, which relate to the Unfair
13 Sales Act; providing for noncodification; and
14 declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
17 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

18 The Oklahoma Legislature recognizes the importance of a free
19 market economy and the benefits of competition that Oklahoma
20 consumers enjoy when restrictions on free trade are removed from the
21 market place. The Oklahoma legislature also recognizes that through
22 innovation and advances in technology, today's Oklahoma consumers
23 have opportunities to trade across state and international borders
24 which did not exist in 1949. Accordingly, the Oklahoma Legislature
believes that certain trade restrictions which were originally
enacted in 1949 on retailers located within the borders of Oklahoma

1 should be removed as these restrictions now serve to place Oklahoma
2 retailers at a competitive disadvantage with retailers located in
3 other jurisdictions.

4 SECTION 2. REPEALER 15 O.S. 2011, Sections 598.1, 598.2,
5 598.3, 598.4, 598.5, 598.6, 598.7, 598.8, 598.9, 598.10 and 598.11,
6 are hereby repealed.

7 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
8 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
9 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
10 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
