6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to children; amending 10 O.S. 2011,
8 Section 601.4, which relates to the Oklahoma
9 Commission on Children and Youth; clarifying
10 language; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 10 O.S. 2011, Section 601.4, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 601.4. The Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth is
15 further authorized to:

16 1. Facilitate joint planning and service coordination among
17 public and private agencies that provide services to children and
18 youth;

19 2. Prepare and publish reports;

20 3. Review the programs, policies and services for children and
21 youth provided by public and private agencies for compliance with
22 established state policies and progress towards goals identified in
23 planning documents relating to children and youth services and to
24 ~~make~~ issue reports regarding such compliance and progress;

1 4. Accept appropriations, gifts, loans and grants from the
2 state and federal government and from other sources, public or
3 private;

4 5. Enter into agreements or contracts for the development of
5 test models or demonstration programs and projects and for programs
6 of practical research for effective services to children and youth;
7 provided that the administration of contract for such model programs
8 and projects shall, within five (5) years of their inception, be
9 transferred to an appropriate agency or the program or project shall
10 be discontinued;

11 6. Secure necessary statistical, technical, administrative,
12 operational and staff services by interagency agreement or contract;

13 7. Examine all records, plans, budgets and budget documents
14 pertaining to the children and youth service system;

15 8. Exercise all incidental powers as necessary and proper for
16 the performance of the duties and responsibilities of the
17 Commission;

18 9. Promulgate rules as necessary to carry out the duties and
19 responsibilities assigned to the Oklahoma Commission on Children and
20 Youth; and

21 10. Recommend that a facility providing services to children
22 and youth be closed or that its contract with the state be
23 terminated.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
