7 An Act relating to medical liability actions;
8 prohibiting admissibility of certain action;
9 prohibiting use of certain action for certain
determination or presumption; providing for
codification; and providing an effective date.

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12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1712 of Title 63, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A physician's failure to comply with or a physician's breach of
17 any federal statute, regulation, program, guideline or other
18 provision shall not be admissible, used to determine the standard of
19 care, or the legal basis for a presumption of negligence in any
20 medical liability action in this state.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.

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
