7 An Act relating to surrogacy; establishing guidelines
8 for certain agreements; providing for codification;
and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 559 of Title 10, unless there is
14 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter or
16 another law, the mother-child relationship exists between a woman
17 and a child born to a gestational mother under a gestational
18 surrogacy agreement if the gestational agreement is found by a court
19 to comply with the provisions of this Article or is enforceable
20 under other law, regardless of the fact that the gestational mother
21 gave birth to the child.

22 B. Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter or
23 another law, the father-child relationship exists between a man and
24 a child born to a gestational mother under a gestational surrogacy

1 agreement if the gestational agreement is found by a court to comply
2 with the provisions of this Article or is enforceable under other
3 law, regardless of the fact that the man is not married to the
4 gestational mother.

5 C. If the intended mother receives eggs donated by a party who
6 has voluntarily relinquished all rights to the eggs, the eggs shall
7 be considered the same as the intended mother's eggs for purposes of
8 this article. Likewise, if the intended father receives sperm
9 donated by a party who has voluntarily relinquished all rights to
10 the sperm, the sperm shall be considered the same as the intended
11 father's sperm for purposes of this article.

12 D. Any child born as a result of donated eggs or sperm to the
13 intended parents in conformance with this article or other laws
14 shall be the same as a naturally conceived legitimate child of the
15 intended parents who consented to and received the donation
16 regardless of whether the child is carried by the intended mother or
17 a gestational mother under a gestational surrogacy agreement.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
