6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to professions and occupations;  
8 amending 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1151.3, which relates  
9 to the Roofing Contractor Registration Act;  
10 clarifying language; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1151.3, is  
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 1151.3. A. A person may not engage in the business nor  
15 act in the capacity of a roofing contractor within this state nor  
16 may that person bring or maintain any claim, action, suit, or  
17 proceeding in any court of this state related to the person's  
18 business or capacity as a roofing contractor without a valid  
19 registration as provided in the Roofing Contractor Registration Act,  
20 Section 1151. et seq. of this title.

21 B. A person who fails to obtain a valid registration prior to  
22 acting as a roofing contractor as defined in the Roofing Contractor  
23 Registration Act, a person who acts as a roofing contractor while  
24 his or her registration is suspended or revoked, or a person who

1 violates any provision of the Roofing Contractor Registration Act  
2 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, upon conviction, punishable by a  
3 fine not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each  
4 violation. More than one violation in any twelve-month period shall  
5 be grounds for the suspension of the registration, and shall cause  
6 the person to be ineligible for registration for a period not to  
7 exceed twelve (12) months.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
