6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to sidearms and badges; amending 74
8 O.S. 2011, Section 150.23, which relates to custody
9 of certain sidearms and badges upon retirement or
10 death; authorizing certain persons to receive certain
11 firearms and badges under certain circumstances; and
12 providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 150.23, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 150.23. A. An officer, investigator, or agent of the
17 Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, the Oklahoma State Bureau of
18 Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control, the Department of Wildlife
19 Conservation, the Law Enforcement Division of the Oklahoma Horse
20 Racing Commission, the State Fire Marshal's Office, the Oklahoma
21 Tourism and Recreation Department, the Office of Inspector General
22 and the Oklahoma Child Support Services divisions of the Department
23 of Human Services, the police departments of the Board of Regents of
24 the University of Oklahoma or the office of a district attorney
shall be entitled to receive, upon retirement by reason of length of

1 service, the continued custody and possession of the sidearm and
2 badge carried by such officer, investigator, or agent immediately
3 prior to retirement.

4 B. An officer, investigator, or agent specified in subsection A
5 of this section may be entitled to receive, upon retirement by
6 reason of disability, the continued custody and possession of the
7 sidearm and badge carried by such officer or agent immediately prior
8 to retirement upon written approval of the applicable Director of
9 the appropriate Bureau, Department, Commission, or district
10 attorney.

11 C. Custody and possession of the sidearm and badge of an
12 officer, investigator, or agent who dies while employed by any
13 Bureau, Department, Commission, or office specified in subsection A
14 of this section may be awarded by the applicable Director of the
15 appropriate Bureau, Department, Commission, or office to the spouse
16 or next of kin of the deceased officer, investigator, or agent.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
