6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to campus police departments;  
8 amending 74 O.S. 2011, Section 360.20, as amended by  
9 Section 5, Chapter 48, O.S.L. 2012 (74 O.S. Supp.  
10 2012, Section 360.20), which relates to  
11 jurisdictional agreements; directing campus police  
12 departments to report certain incidents; directing  
13 certain employees to report certain incidents;  
14 providing an effective date; and declaring an  
15 emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 360.20, as  
18 amended by Section 5, Chapter 48, O.S.L. 2012 (74 O.S. Supp. 2012,  
19 Section 360.20), is amended to read as follows:

20 Section 360.20. A. Municipalities and county sheriff  
21 departments having overlapping or concurrent jurisdiction with a  
22 proposed campus police department, may enter into agreements with  
23 the proposed campus police department recognizing jurisdictional  
24 boundaries and providing for mutual assistance. Any such agreements  
shall be executed by the governing boards of the educational  
institution or airport public trust and the governing body of the

1 municipality or sheriff, and shall not serve to prevent other law  
2 enforcement agencies from having concurrent or overlapping  
3 jurisdiction. Nothing in Section 360.15 et seq. of this title or  
4 any action pursuant to Section 360.15 et seq. of this title shall be  
5 deemed to create an agent-principal relationship between any campus  
6 police officer and any municipality or county.

7 B. All public institutions within the Oklahoma State System of  
8 Higher Education that have established campus police departments  
9 pursuant to Section 360.18 of this title shall enter into and become  
10 a party to mutual aid agreements with municipal police departments  
11 or county sheriff departments to investigate cases of sexual assault  
12 or violent crimes.

13 C. Campus police officers authorized under Section 360.17 of  
14 this title shall notify municipal police departments or county  
15 sheriff departments with whom the institution of higher education  
16 has entered into a mutual aid agreement upon receiving a report of  
17 sexual assault or violent crime or upon observing or gaining  
18 knowledge of a sexual assault or violent crime.

19 D. All employees of institutions within the Oklahoma State  
20 System of Higher Education who observe, receive information or have  
21 knowledge of a sexual assault or violent crime involving a student  
22 shall notify the municipal police department or county sheriff  
23 department serving the area in which the institution is located.

24 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2013.

1       SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
