6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to bail bondsmen; construing bond
8 limit in certain counties; providing for
9 codification; providing an effective date; and
10 declaring an emergency.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1320.1 of Title 59, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 Pursuant to Section 1320 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes, a
16 bondsman is authorized to write bonds on up to ten (10) defendants
17 per year January 1 through December 31 in each county outside his or
18 her resident county. For purposes of determining the ten-defendant
19 bond limit pursuant to Section 1320 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma
20 Statutes, the bondsman shall consider each date a bond or bonds are
21 written on a single individual as being one of the ten-defendant
22 limit notwithstanding any previous bonds which have been written on
23 that same individual. The ten-defendant limit does not apply in
24 counties without a registered bondsman in such county.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2013.

2 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
3 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
4 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
5 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
