6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the State Capitol building;
8 amending 73 O.S. 2011, Section 15.1, as amended by
9 Section 659, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (73 O.S. Supp.
10 2012, Section 15.1), which relates to management and
11 control of space within the State Capitol building;
12 granting authority to manage and control certain
13 space to the Office of Management and Enterprise
14 Services; and declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 73 O.S. 2011, Section 15.1, as
17 amended by Section 659, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (73 O.S. Supp.
18 2012, Section 15.1), is amended to read as follows:

19 Section 15.1. A. The Legislature shall have management and
20 control of the following space in the State Capitol Building:

- 21 1. The space on the third, fourth, fifth and sixth floors;
- 22 2. The space in the basement that is occupied by the
23 Legislature on June 1, 1995;
- 24 3. Approximately six thousand nine hundred thirty-nine (6,939)
square feet of space in the west wing of the first floor that is
occupied by the Department of Libraries on June 1, 1995;

1 4. Approximately six thousand six hundred ninety-one (6,691)
2 square feet of space in the west wing of the basement that is
3 occupied by the Department of Libraries and the Office of Management
4 and Enterprise Services on June 1, 1995;

5 5. Approximately three thousand seven hundred seventy (3,770)
6 square feet of space in the west wing of the basement that is
7 occupied by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services on June
8 1, 1995;

9 6. Approximately two thousand one hundred (2,100) square feet
10 of space in the center of the basement that is occupied by the
11 Office of Management and Enterprise Services on June 1, 1995;

12 7. Approximately six hundred (600) square feet of space in the
13 center of the basement that is occupied by the Office of Management
14 and Enterprise Services on June 1, 1995;

15 8. Approximately two thousand three hundred one (2,301) square
16 feet of space in the center of the basement that is occupied by the
17 Office of Management and Enterprise Services on June 1, 1995;

18 9. Approximately twelve thousand five hundred sixty (12,560)
19 square feet of space in the west wing of the first floor that is
20 occupied by the Office of the Attorney General on June 1, 2001;
21 provided, upon the Office of the Attorney General vacating such
22 space, any renovations thereto shall be made in such a manner as to
23 ensure preservation and maintenance of the cultural and historic
24 integrity of the Capitol; and

1 10. Upon completion of the project authorized in Section 332 of
2 this title, all space in the west wing of the second floor that is
3 occupied by the Supreme Court, all space in the north wing of the
4 second floor that is occupied by the Court of Criminal Appeals and
5 any other space in the State Capitol Building that is occupied by
6 the appellate courts prior to relocation to the Wiley Post
7 Historical Building; provided, r:

8 a. the Supreme Court shall continue to have exclusive
9 management and control of the Supreme Court courtroom
10 and designated robing room located in the west wing of
11 the second floor and,

12 b. the Court of Criminal Appeals shall continue to have
13 access to the courtroom and designated robing room
14 located in the north wing of the second floor upon
15 such occasions as the Presiding Judge of the Court of
16 Criminal Appeals deems necessary and appropriate, and

17 c. the Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall
18 have management and control over approximately one
19 thousand eight hundred sixty-five square feet
20 designated for use as a fitness center located
21 adjacent to the southwest stairwell in the basement.

22 B. The authority of the Legislature to allot space may be
23 delegated to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker
24 of the House of Representatives. Each House of the State

1 Legislature shall have the exclusive charge of the purchase, use,
2 allotment, and disposition of its respective chambers, committee
3 rooms, fixtures, furniture, supplies, and apparatus, and shall be
4 responsible for the use and preservation of same. The provisions of
5 this section shall not prohibit the Legislature from allowing
6 agencies of the executive or judicial departments to use space
7 within the State Capitol Building that is under its management and
8 control.

9 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
10 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
11 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
12 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
