10 A Concurrent Resolution applauding and recognizing
11 the many contributions made by American women
12 throughout the Nation's history; recognizing and
13 celebrating March as National Women's History Month.

14 WHEREAS, American women of every race, class, and ethnic
15 background have made historic contributions to the development,
16 growth and strength of our Nation in countless recorded and
17 unrecorded ways; and

18 WHEREAS, American women have played and continue to play a
19 critical economic, cultural and social role in every sphere of the
20 lives of the people of our Nation by constituting a significant
21 portion of the labor force working inside and outside of the home;

23 WHEREAS, American women have played a unique role throughout the
24 history of our Nation by providing the majority of the volunteer

1 labor force. American women were particularly important in the
2 establishment of the early charitable, philanthropic and cultural
3 institutions of our Nation; and

4 WHEREAS, American women from all walks of life have served as
5 leaders in the forefront of every major movement to restore and
6 safeguard the rights and liberties guaranteed by the Constitution of
7 the United States. They have been leaders, not only in securing
8 their own rights of suffrage and equal opportunity, but also in the
9 abolitionist movement, the emancipation movement, the industrial
10 labor movement, the civil rights movement, and other movements to
11 create a just society for all.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION
13 OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
14 CONCURRING THEREIN:
