6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Joint Resolution relating to bicycle routes;
8 designating Route 66 as Oklahoma's Official Bicycle
9 Route; directing the Department of Transportation to
10 submit an application; allowing the Department of
11 Transportation or municipalities to place permanent
12 markers; and directing distribution.

13 WHEREAS, a nationwide effort has been launched to designate
14 Route 66 as the Official Bicycle Route within each state it passes
15 through; and

16 WHEREAS, Oklahoma has over 430 driveable miles along Route 66,
17 the most of any state in the country; and

18 WHEREAS, over thirty-two (32) municipalities through which Route
19 66 runs have offered their overwhelming support to designate Route
20 66 as Oklahoma's Official Bicycle Route.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF
22 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

23 SECTION 1. Route 66 extending throughout the State of Oklahoma
24 shall be designated as Oklahoma's Official Bicycle Route.

1 SECTION 2. The Department of Transportation shall submit an
2 application to the American Association of State Highway and
3 Transportation Officials with the intention of adding Route 66 to
4 the U.S. Bicycle Route System.

5 SECTION 3. The Department of Transportation or any local
6 municipality which the route runs through may erect suitable
7 permanent markers designating the route.

8 SECTION 4. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to
9 distribute copies of this resolution to the Department of
10 Transportation.
