6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Joint Resolution relating to juries; ordering a
8 legislative referendum pursuant to the Oklahoma
9 Constitution; amending 38 O.S. 2011, Section 106,
10 which relates to completed petition; updating
11 statutory reference; providing ballot title; and
12 directing filing.

13 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
14 1ST SESSION OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

15 SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 3 of Article V of the Oklahoma
16 Constitution, there is hereby ordered the following legislative
17 referendum which shall be filed with the Secretary of State and
18 addressed to the Governor of the state, who shall submit the same to
19 the people for their approval or rejection at the next General
20 Election.

21 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 38 O.S. 2011, Section 106, is
22 amended to read as follows:

23 Section 106. Upon the obtaining of the signatures, and within
24 the forty-five day time limitation provided in Section ~~3~~ 103 of this
~~act~~ title, the completed petitions shall be filed with the court

1 clerk. The court clerk shall copy said petitions and deliver the
2 originals on the next business day, excluding Saturdays, Sundays and
3 holidays, to the election board. Upon the delivery of said
4 petitions to the election board, the board shall have seven (7)
5 business days, excluding Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, to
6 determine how many of the signers of said petitions are qualified
7 electors within the county and shall return, not later than the
8 seventh business day, excluding Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, the
9 original petitions to the court clerk together with a certification
10 of the number of such signers who are qualified electors within the
11 county.

12 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective upon approval by the
13 people.

14 SECTION 4. The Ballot Title for the proposed act shall be in
15 the following form:

1 SECTION 5. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall,
2 immediately after the passage of this order for legislative
3 referendum, prepare and file in accordance with Section 3 of Article
4 V of the Oklahoma Constitution, one copy of this order for
5 legislative referendum, including the Ballot Title set forth in
6 SECTION 4, with the Secretary of State and one copy with the
7 Attorney General.
