6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State
8 to refer to the people for their approval or
9 rejection a proposed amendment to the Oklahoma
10 Constitution by adding a new Section 26A to Article
11 X; authorizing a school district to provide payment
12 for compensable accrued leave or other benefits from
13 a previous fiscal year; authorizing a school district
14 employee to carry forward unused accrued leave;
15 providing ballot title; and directing filing.

16 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
17 2ND SESSION OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

18 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
19 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
20 the following proposed amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution by
21 adding a new Section 26A to Article X to read as follows:

22 Section 26A. A. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 26
23 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution, a school district shall
24 be authorized to:

1. Provide payment to a school district employee for any
compensable accrued leave or other benefits accumulated during a

1 previous fiscal year while he or she was an employee of the
2 district; and

3 2. Allow a school district employee to carry forward any unused
4 accrued leave earned while employed by the district from one fiscal
5 year to the next fiscal year.

6 B. The Legislature shall enact laws to carry out the provisions
7 of this section.

8 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
9 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
10 the following form:

11 BALLOT TITLE

12 Legislative Referendum No. _____ State Question No. _____

13 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

14 This measure adds a new section of law to the State
15 Constitution. It adds Section 26A to Article 10. It allows a
16 school district to pay an employee for unused leave time. It
17 allows a school district employee to carry over benefits from
18 one year to the next year. It directs the Legislature to pass
19 laws to implement this measure.
