7 A Resolution proclaiming April 2, 2013, as Oklahoma
8 4-H Day at the Capitol; and directing distribution.

10 WHEREAS, 4-H youth across the nation are leading a revolution of
11 responsibility in their communities, focusing on the fourth H -
12 Health; Health for better living in my club, my community, my
13 country, and my world; and

14 WHEREAS, 4-H is the largest youth development organization in
15 Oklahoma and the largest in the nation with six million young
16 people; and

17 WHEREAS, 4-H in Oklahoma reaches 114,000 youth members and 9,000
18 volunteers annually; and

19 WHEREAS, 4-H as part of the Oklahoma Cooperative Extension
20 Service provided by Langston University and Oklahoma State
21 University, where youth are encouraged to discover their passion,
22 adopt a growth mindset, practice self-reflection and set goals which
23 contribute to a healthy lifestyle; and

1 WHEREAS, 4-H has connected youth and their communities with the
2 innovative research and resources from our nation's 106 land-grant
3 universities and colleges for more than 100 years; and

4 WHEREAS, 4-H youth are the "now", the living, breathing,
5 cultural change agents leading a revolution of responsibility for
6 doing the right thing, breaking through obstacles and making a
7 measurable difference in the communities and state where they live.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION
9 OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

10 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate proclaims April 2, 2013, as the
11 17th Annual 4-H Day at the Oklahoma State Capitol, celebrating youth
12 who have made an impact on their community and accepted the
13 challenges of a complex and changing world, and challenge others to
14 join their Revolution of Responsibility.
