COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Corporation Commission;
requiring budgeting in certain categories and
amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
providing for duties and compensation of employees;
providing budgetary limitations; providing an
effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, the
Corporation Commission shall budget all funds in the following
categories and amounts:

8 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
9 each budget category.

10 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
11 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
12 upon the Corporation Commission by law shall be set by the General
13 Administrator. The Corporation Commission shall be subject to the
14 following budgetary limitations on expenditures excluding direct
15 expenditures for well plugging as authorized in Section 310 of Title
16 52 of the Oklahoma Statutes, pit closure as authorized in Section
17 140 of Title 52 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and remediation of sites
18 as authorized in Section 353 of Title 17 of the Oklahoma Statutes,
19 and as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603
20 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

23 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2013.

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1 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this resolution shall take
4 effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
