11 An Act relating to the Oklahoma School of Science and
12 Mathematics; authorizing the Board of Trustees of the
13 Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics to
14 establish a policy to accept certain students, offer
15 for rent certain facilities and establish certain
16 summer programs; directing the Board of Trustees to
17 submit certain report; providing for codification;
18 providing an effective date; and declaring an
19 emergency.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1210.405 of Title 70, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

24 A. The Board of Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and
Mathematics, upon a finding of unused capacity within the Oklahoma

1 School of Science and Mathematics (OSSM), shall have the authority
2 to:

3 1. Establish a policy providing for the acceptance of students
4 residing outside of Oklahoma and outside the United States for
5 enrollment in courses offered by OSSM in an amount not to exceed ten
6 percent (10%) of the total enrollment of OSSM. The policy shall
7 include but not be limited to:

8 a. a method of calculating rates for nonresident tuition
9 and room and board which must meet or exceed the cost
10 of attendance, subject to limits prescribed by the
11 Legislature, and

12 b. a provision that residents of Oklahoma seeking
13 acceptance to OSSM be given priority for enrollment
14 over students who are not residents of the state, if
15 all other qualifications are equal;

16 2. Offer for rent dormitories, classrooms, laboratories or
17 other OSSM facilities located in Oklahoma City; and

18 3. Establish educational programs and professional development
19 workshops to be offered during summer periods for which tuition and
20 fee rates may be established.

21 B. By January 1 of each year, the Board shall submit a report
22 to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore and the Minority Leader
23 of the Senate, the Speaker and the Minority Leader of the House of
24 Representatives, the chair of the Senate Education Committee and the

1 chair of the House Common Education Committee that includes the
2 nonresident tuition and room and board rates approved by the Board
3 for the current academic year. The annual report shall include data
4 on the impact of any tuition increases on the ability of students to
5 meet the costs of attendance, enrollment patterns and any other data
6 considered relevant by the Board.

7 C. The Board shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions
8 of this section.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2013.

10 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
11 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
12 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
13 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
