5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to workers' compensation; amending 85  
7 O.S. 2011, Section 319, which relates to dismissal of  
8 claim; updating statutory reference; and providing an  
effective date.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 85 O.S. 2011, Section 319, is  
11 amended to read as follows:

12 Section 319. Any claimant may, upon the payment of the Workers'  
13 Compensation Court's filing fee, dismiss any claim brought by the  
14 claimant at any time before final submission of the case to the  
15 Court for decision. Such dismissal shall be without prejudice  
16 unless the words "with prejudice" are included in the order. If any  
17 claim that is filed within the statutory time permitted by Section  
18 ~~18~~ 318 of this ~~act~~ title is dismissed without prejudice, a new claim  
19 may be filed within one (1) year after the entry of the order  
20 dismissing the first claim even if the statutory time for filing has  
21 expired.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
