11 An Act relating to the Corporation Commission;
12 setting certain budget limits; providing an effective
date; and declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, the budget
17 limit for the Public Utility Division of the Corporation Commission
18 shall be set at Six Million Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars
19 (\$6,900,000.00).

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, the budget
21 limit for the Corporation Commission to fulfill the duties assigned
22 by the Nonconsensual Towing Act of 2011 shall be set at One Hundred
23 Twenty-six Thousand Dollars (\$126,000.00).

24 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2014.

1 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
