The **CCR** on **HB 2097** was called up for consideration.

Representative Sherrer raised a point of order as to whether the **CCR** on **HB 2097** was in order pursuant to House Rule 8.12. Representative Sherrer stated that the language in the **CCR** is similar to the language in **SB 802** which failed in a House committee.

The Presiding Officer stated that House Rule 8.12 governs consideration of floor amendments during the General Order phase of the legislative process and that the **CCR** on **HB 2097** was not presently on General Order and that no floor amendment was presently under consideration. The Presiding Officer stated further that **SB 802** did not receive final

action in a House committee but rather underwent a failed “Do Pass” motion. As such, the Presiding Officer ruled the point not well taken.

Representative Morrissette raised a point of inquiry as to where it is stated in House Rules that the Speaker has the authority to refer a measure to a special conference committee, to which the Presiding Officer replied House Rule 1.9.
