

# HOUSE JOURNAL

**Second Regular Session of the Fifty-fourth Legislature**

**Eighth Legislative Day, Thursday, February 13, 2014**

## **GENERAL ORDER**

Announcing the passage of **SB 906**. The measure was introduced and read for the first time.

**SB 906** – By Johnson (Rob) and Sparks of the Senate and Armes of the House.

An Act relating to presidential elections; establishing the Agreement Among the States to Elect the President by National Popular Vote; stating the intent of the state to join in the Agreement and become a member state of the Agreement Among the States to Elect the President by National Popular Vote; providing that any state is eligible to become a member state; providing for a statewide popular election for President and Vice President of the United States; establishing a procedure for appointing presidential electors in member states; specifying when the Agreement becomes effective; providing for the withdrawal of a member state; requiring notification of member states; specifying that the provisions of the Agreement are severable; defining certain terms; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.
