Research Analysis

The CS for HB 1002 creates the Cost Reduction and Savings Act of 2013 and requires the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) to identify the ten state agencies with the lowest rankings in the financial services cost performance assessment published by the Office and requires those agencies to contract with OMES to provide shared financial services if it will result in cost savings or efficiencies to the state. The bill prohibits a contracted agency from discontinuing the shared services unless the agency can document that it can provide the services at a lower cost and such documentation is approved by the Director of OMES.

Additionally, the measure authorizes OMES to enter into contracts to carry out the functions of the State Employee Assistance Program; modifies who is eligible to participate in the Carl Albert Public Internship Program; and modifies how the cumulative total of FTE positions for state agencies is calculated.

Fiscal Analysis

The Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) indicates provisions related to the modification of internship will have a projected savings of \$363,538, based on fourteen (14) undergraduates times a turnover cost of \$25,967.

Provisions related to allowing OMES to enter into contracts with Employee Assistance Program (EAP) providers is requiring continued analysis as to potential savings resulting from combining with other state agency EAP programs and the potential of privatization.
