Research Analysis

The CS for HB 1083 modifies and updates several definitions in the Oklahoma Emergency Response Systems Development Act and requires the State Commissioner of Health to maintain a registry of critical care paramedics. Furthermore, only paramedic training programs accredited or under review by the Committee on Accreditation of Educational Programs for the Emergency Medical Services Professions may enroll new paramedic students. Additionally, licensed specialty care ambulance providers can only be used for interhospital transport if the patient requires specialized enroute medical monitoring and advanced life support that exceeds the capabilities of paramedic life support. Finally, the measure repeals the Commissioner's ability to issue a temporary emergency medical technician license without an examination.
