The CS for HB 1099 creates the 11 member Rural Oklahoma Healthcare Task Force. The purpose of the Task Force is to study healthcare issues in rural Oklahoma and make recommendations on ways to improve both accessibility and utilization. The task force will conclude and present a final report to the Governor, the Speaker of the House, and the President Pro Tempore no later than December 31st, 2013.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1099 as introduced, creates a 11 member Task Force with membership appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.
