The committee substitute extends until May 31, 2014, the Rethinking Special Education, Competency and Transition Task Force and makes its final report due January 1, 2014. The committee substitute also requires that the State Department of Education rather than the Oklahoma Commission on Youth and Children administer the Interagency Coordinating Council for Early Childhood Intervention.

**Fiscal Analysis**

Committee Sub. for HB 1264 extends the Rethinking Special Education, Competency and Transition Task Force until May 31, 2014. Further, the administrator of the Interagency Coordinating Council for Early Childhood Intervention is changed from the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth to the State Department of Education. The measure has no fiscal impact.
