The CS for HB 1389 authorizes a governing body of a city or town to annex any territory adjacent or contiguous to the city or town, without providing notice and public hearing, if the governing body obtains the written consent of all property owners of 100% of the the territory to be annexed.

Fiscal Analysis

The provision offers an annexation method that would eliminate a potential cost for providing legal notice, a cost which would, if otherwise necessary, vary by the size of notice and publication. The provision does not describe or set forth the method of obtaining written consent from all property owners in such circumstances.
