Research Analysis

The CS for HB 1465 creates the “Quantification of State Government Performance Act of 2013” and requires each state agency to submit a program management and performance report to the Speaker of the House, Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Director of the Office of Management Enterprise Services (OMES). The report is to include the purpose of each agency program, outcomes achieved, level of efficiency and effectiveness with which the program is administered, cost avoidance and cost containment measures implemented, the methodology for determining the agency’s fee structure and gauging customer satisfaction, and a list of programs or operations not required as part of the core function of the agency. The measure also requires the Director of OMES to make the reports available on the state’s public access website.
