**Research Analysis**

The CS for HB 1470 creates the Cost Reduction, Efficiency and Reform Act of 2013. The measure:

- Deletes the Laboratory Services Advisory Council of the Environmental Quality Board;
- Places the Advisory Committee for Motorcycle Safety and Education under the authority of the Oklahoma Highway Safety Office;
- Places the Commission on Marginally Producing Oil and Gas Wells under the authority of the Oklahoma Energy Resources Board and repeals certain statutes related to the Commission;
- Repeals the Waterworks and Wastewater Works Advisory Council;
- Deletes the Advisory Council of the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training;
- Combines the Bomb Dog Advisory Council with the Drug Dog Advisory Council; and
- Consolidates the Oklahoma Bioenergy Center and the Oklahoma Bioenergy Board into the Oklahoma Energy Initiative and the Oklahoma Energy Initiative Board.

**Fiscal Analysis**

CS for HB 1470 consolidates several state entities, repeals others, and reduces service overlap by providing for a more streamlined operation of these entities. Potential savings can be realized by a reduction in travel reimbursement, in personnel, and in a more efficient delivery of state services.
