Research Analysis

HB 1476 requires the Department of Public Safety to modify the application for the issuance of a Class D driver license or identification card to contain a statement of exemption which would allow an applicant to exempt themselves from supplying biometric data to the Department. The measure places restrictions on the use of facial images stored by the Department.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials with the Department of Public Safety (DPS) indicate they have received analysis from the agency's vendor for the drivers' license system as to the impact the measure would have on the system. DPS reports they were verbally provided "a very rough estimate" of \$800,000 to modify the system to comply with the provisions of the measure.
