**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1532, as introduced, amends the distribution of unclaimed lottery prize money. The measure increases the allotment to the Department of Mental Health to \$750,000 of unclaimed prize money, up from \$500,000. This money was originally earmarked to increase lottery prize payout and so this measure would have no direct state fiscal impact.
