Research Analysis

The Committee Substitute for HB1638 creates the Oklahoma Agritourism Activities Liability Limitations Act and requires agritourism professionals to post and maintain a warning notice at the entrance and site of the agritourism event. In the event of injury or death of a participant, the measure provides that an agritourism professional, whose agritourism activity is registered with the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry, is not liable, provided a warning label is posted and the injury was a result of an inherent risk of the agritourism activity. Willful disregard for the well-being of the participant or knowledge of dangerous conditions voids the limited liability provided by the measure.
