Research Analysis

The committee substitute requires that initial allocations of state aid for nonresident, transferred students enrolled in online courses be determined by using enrollment as of August 1 multiplied by a weight of 1.333. Foundation aid for those students will be determined using the district's weighted average daily membership of the first nine weeks of the current school year. Allocations for January, February and March will be based upon enrollment of the first nine weeks of the school year. Starting July 1, 2014, no school district will offer full-time virtual or online education to students who are not residents of the district.

Fiscal Analysis

Committee Sub. for HB 1660 modifies initial allocation for certain pupils in on-line courses to be determined by multiplying the actual enrollment as of August 1 by a 1.333 weight. The measure specifies certain weighted membership from nonresident, transferred pupils enrolled in online courses, and specifies initial and other allocations. The measure has no fiscal impact.
