Research Analysis

The CS for HB 1794 creates the Oklahoma State Government Act of 2013. The measure provides a payment of \$1,000 for those classified and non-classified public employees who receive a “meets standards” or above on his or her performance evaluation.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure provides a performance payment of \$1,000 for each state employee who has received a “meets standards” or above on his or her performance evaluation. Recent data indicate an employee count of between 34,000 and 35,000 in the classified and unclassified service. The percentage of employees meeting or exceeding standards will need to be determined, as well as adjustments for the percentage of employments costs made by federal resources, before a precise estimate can be completed. The maximum potential cost to agencies is likely to be less than the \$34.4 million (based on 100 percent participation).
