Research Analysis

The committee substitute directs the State Board of Education to establish a system of safeguards to protect student privacy and ensure the integrity of the state student data system. The State Board of Education will publish individual student-level data currently in the student data system that is required to be reported by state and federal education mandates and any student data proposed for inclusion in the student data system. The board must develop policies to comply with the Federal Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act and other relevant privacy laws and policies. The department must use only aggregate data in public reports. The measure prohibits the department from providing individual student data to other organizations or agencies outside the state unless exceptions outlined are met. The department must develop a detailed data security plan.

The committee substitute also requires that libraries supported by public funds not release information collected from minors except to library staff working within the scope of their duties, a person authorized by the individual or to comply with a court order.
