HB 2014, as introduced, directs the Governor to inform the Secretary of the Department of Health and Human Services that the state will not opt out of the federal law that disqualifies individuals who have been convicted of a felony drug offense from qualifying for the food stamp program. The bill also makes individuals who have over \$2,000 in a bank account ineligible to receive food stamps.
