**Research Analysis**

The CS for HB 2215 modifies the definition of “recovery and recovery support,” and modifies the description of “community-based structured crisis center” to include comprehensive community addiction recovery centers. The Board of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services will promulgate rules and standards for comprehensive community addiction recovery centers. Additionally, the measure adds the term “faith-based” to the Oklahoma Alcohol and Drug Abuse Services Act. Lastly, the measure adds faith-based nonresidential recovery programs and residential recovery-based programs with a resident capacity of less than twelve to the list of exemptions under the Oklahoma Alcohol and Drug Abuse Services Act.
