Research Analysis

HB 2221 provides that a property owner, tenant, employer, place of worship or business entity can prohibit the carrying of a concealed or unconcealed firearm on the property. If the building or property is open to the public, the property owner, tenant, employer, place of worship or business entity must post signs on or about the property stating the prohibition. A person carrying a firearm may be denied entrance to the property or removed from the property. A person refusing to leave may be issued a citation not to exceed \$250. Property owners who do allow firearms on the property are immune from any liability. Employers who allow employees to carry firearms on the property are immune from liability.
