Research Analysis

HB2312 clarifies that a licensed architect or professional engineer who receives civil immunity for providing architectural, structural, electrical, mechanical or other design professional services may be reimbursed for the cost of producing a report but not for the time or effort involved in producing the report. The service may include a risk assessment that outlines options for hardening or installation of safe rooms in a school or recommendation for safe refuge areas already existing in a school. The measure also require a municipality, that experiences damages to a city or state owned structure that resulted in at least one human fatality, to allow an independent investigation to be conducted by a team of licensed professional engineers and at least one professor of civil engineering from an Oklahoma university.
