**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure provides for establishing a ceiling on the amount of travel allowance for county commissioners and other county officers. By setting a ceiling counties who choose to provide an allowance may set the amount at or below the ceiling, offering an opportunity to limit costs.

While the measure increases the monthly travel allowance for county commissioners from \$600.00 per month to \$950.00, the statute provides that the allowance is permissive. To the extent counties provide an allowance the cost would increase by \$350.00 per commissioner.
