**Research Analysis**

The CS for HB 2585 allows any party to file an application for an emergency hearing that demonstrates harm to the health, safety or welfare of a child who is the subject of a deprived child proceeding. If the court does not conduct a hearing within 72 hours, the party who filed the application can present it to the presiding judge who must conduct a hearing within 24 hours of receiving the application.
