Fiscal Analysis

The CS for HB2666 adds synthetic controlled substances to the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act, which may increase the number of persons convicted for violations of the Act. Any person convicted in violation of this Act and sentenced to the custody of the Department of Corrections will cost the state approximately \$49 per day for each day of incarceration. The fiscal impact would be dependent upon the number of adjudicated cases and the prison term imposed.
