Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB 2807 creates the Oklahoma Community Protection Act. The measure prohibits the adoption of policies that restrict private property right without due process. The measure provides specific due process and declares that any changes made due to international or federal actions not be considered permanent and will be subject to change. Further, the measure declares that any money allocated, accepted, spent, or promised be considered the property of the affected political subdivision any debt or commitment to an international or federal entity where citizens were not able to exercise their constitutional rights be considered void. The measure specifies specific damages. The measure provides for exception.
