Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB 2922 provides that the decision to retain a student under the Reading Sufficiency Act will be made by the parent or guardian, their teacher, and the building administrator or their representative, if test results are not returned to the school district by the second Friday of May of the same year. Additionally, students in the twelfth grade do not have to demonstrate mastery in the subject area of an end-of-instruction test if their results are not returned to the school district by June 1 of the same year.
